





User centric localized alerts






RSS communication

Add emergency contact directory page




Chat messaging communication

Experts recommend storing enough provisions to sustain everyone in your family — including pets — at least three days. Keep these items in a designated place where they're protected from damage and separate from things you use every day. Should you become separated from family members, use your communication plan. Letting family and friends know you are safe and well can bring them peace of mind.

Essential emergency supplies

At a minimum your emergency supply kit should include these 10

essential items. 1. WATER FOR 3-10 DAYS

(1 gallon per person per day) 2. FOOD FOR 3-10 DAYS

(including pet food) 3. MEDICATIONS (prescription and non-prescription)

4. RADIO (& extra batteries)

5. FLASHLIGHTS

(and extra batteries) 6. FIRST AID KIT

(bandages, disinfecting wipes gauzes, medical tape)

7. CASH AND IMPORTANT **DOCUMENTS** (small bills, coins, birth certificates,

medical cards, licenses, USB) 8. SANITATION AND HYGIENE

SUPPLIES 9. TOOLS (wrench, duct tape, fire

extinguisher, sturdy gloves 10. CLOTHING AND STURDY SHOES
