Essential emergency supplies

At a minimum your emergency supply kit should include these 10

essential items. 1. WATER FOR 3-10 DAYS

(1 gallon per person per day)

2. FOOD FOR 3-10 DAYS (including pet food)

3. MEDICATIONS (prescription and non-prescription)

4. RADIO (& extra batteries)

5. FLASHLIGHTS

(and extra batteries)

6. FIRST AID KIT (bandages, disinfecting wipes

gauzes, medical tape) 7. CASH AND IMPORTANT

DOCUMENTS (small bills, coins, birth certificates,

medical cards, licenses, USB) 8. SANITATION AND HYGIENE

SUPPLIES

9. TOOLS

(wrench, duct tape, fire extinguisher, sturdy gloves

10. CLOTHING AND STURDY SHOES
